REGULAR SESSION

The Governing Body met in Regular Session in the City Council Chambers at 7:30 p.m. Mayor Mike Allison called the meeting to order with the following present: Councilmembers Mike Zinn, Allene Owen, Wayne Henneke, Vicki Berryman Joel Jackson, Dana Dawson and Cory Zimmerman. Councilperson Brock McPherson was absent. Also in attendance were the City Administrator Howard Partington and City Attorney Robert Suelter.

A. CONSENT AGENDA

- a) **Minutes:** Minutes of the Regular Session held on December 19, 2016.

 - a. 309 3rd Street. Trash and refuse including, but not limited to, vehicle tires, vehicle parts, scrap metal, scrap wood, junk, bicycles, scooters, appliances and general refuse are located on the real estate at 309 3rd

Street constituting an unlawful accumulation. This real estate is the subject of Resolution Number 010317-A.

- b. 403 Dogwood. Trash and refuse including, but not limited to, old carpet, vehicle tires, vehicle parts, construction debris, demolition debris and household trash are located on the real estate at 403 Dogwood constituting an unlawful accumulation. This real estate is the subject of Resolution Number 010317-B.
- c. 801 Hubbard. Trash and refuse including, but not limited to, vehicle tires, discarded mattresses and box springs, discarded carpet and padding, old furniture and tree limbs are located on the real estate at 801 Hubbard constituting an unlawful accumulation. This real estate is the subject of Resolution Number 010317-C.
- d. 1800 7th Street. Trash and refuse including, but not limited to, tires, appliances, discarded wood and discarded construction materials are located on the real estate at 1800 7th Street constituting an unlawful accumulation. This real estate is the subject of Resolution Number 010317-D.
- e. 301 Cedar. A black Mercury Grand Marquis and a maroon Ford Victoria not displaying current registration are located on the real estate at 301 Cedar constituting a motor vehicle nuisance. This real estate is the subject of Resolution Number 010317-E.
- f. 1807 Stone. There is a silver Chevrolet pickup that is not displaying current registration and/or is not in operable condition located on the real estate located at 1807 Stone constituting a motor vehicle nuisance. This real estate is the subject of Resolution Number 010317-F.
